## Connect to Server Using NX Client Windows/Linux/Mac (OSX 10.3, 10.4, 10.5, 10.6)

For newer Mac OSX (>10.7), please refer to another document called Day1\_Utility\_10\_7.

In order to connect to the server, you must first install the NX client on your remote machine. It can be downloaded from <u>NoMachine</u> (http://www.nomachine.com/download.php), among other places.

[A] Install **NX Client** with default options; just continue until you reach the completion of installation.



[B] Launch the NX client (For the first time, it opens NX Connection Wizard).
