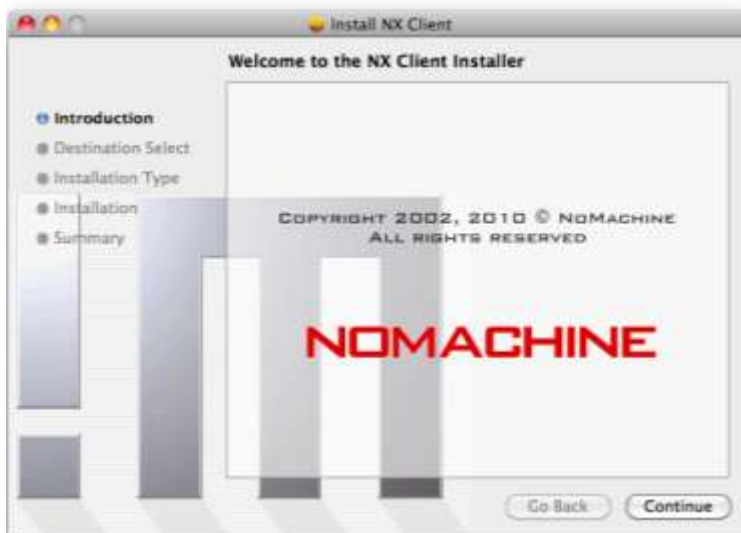


Connect to Server Using NX Client Windows/Linux/Mac (OSX 10.3, 10.4, 10.5, 10.6)

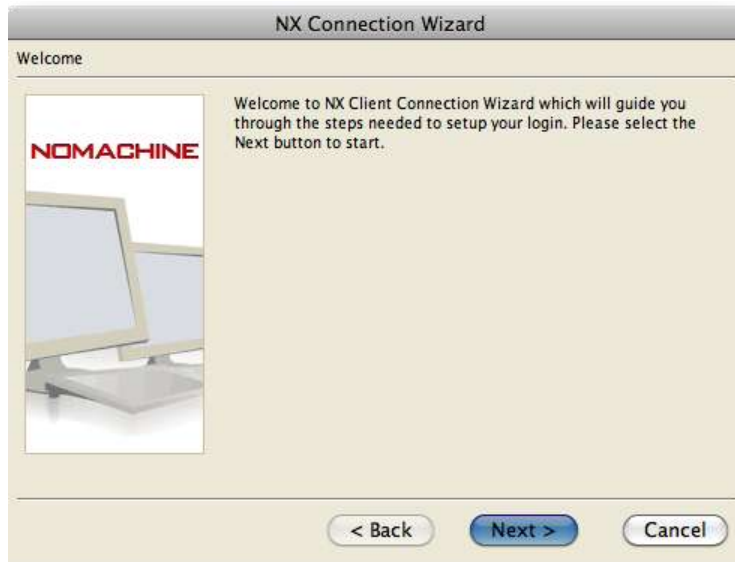
For newer Mac OSX (>10.7), please refer to another document called Day1_Utility_10_7.

In order to connect to the server, you must first install the NX client on your remote machine. It can be downloaded from [NoMachine](http://www.nomachine.com/download.php) (<http://www.nomachine.com/download.php>), among other places.

[A] Install **NX Client** with default options; just continue until you reach the completion of installation.

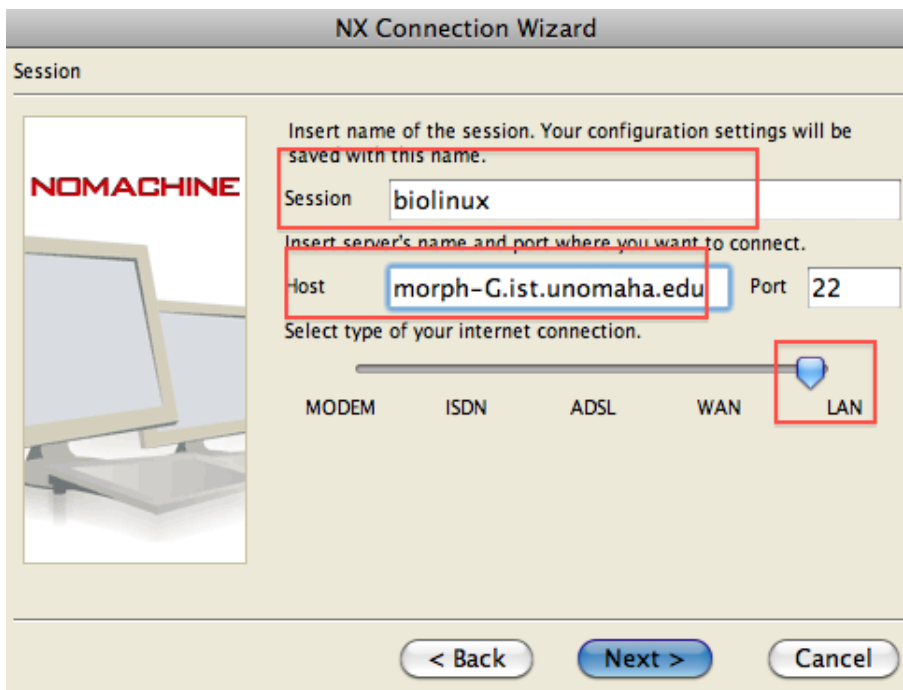


[B] Launch the NX client (For the first time, it opens NX Connection Wizard).

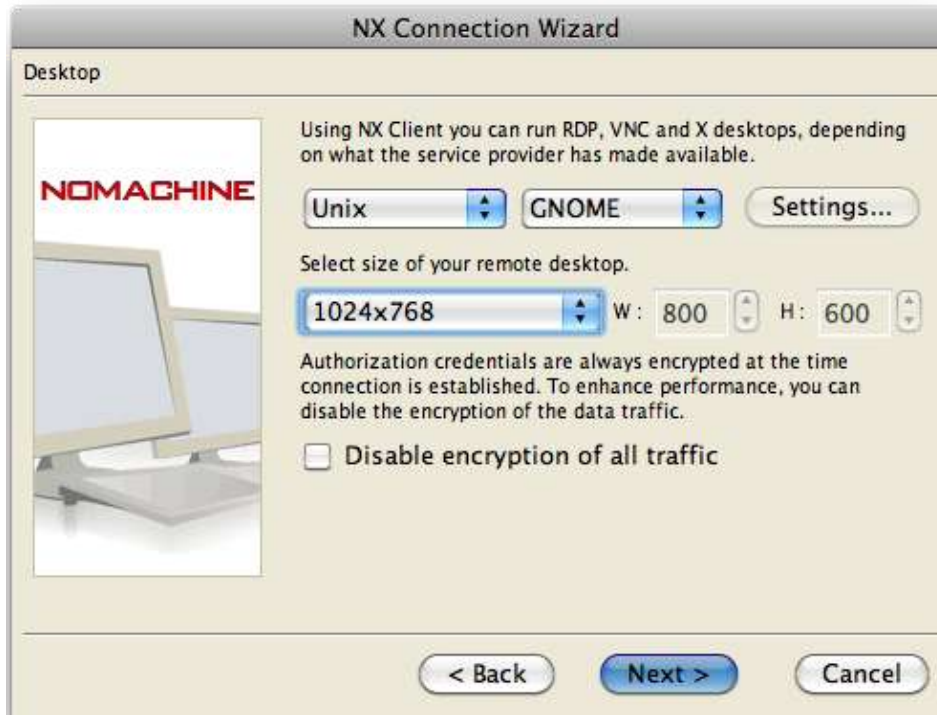


[C] Enter the name of the session, hostname of the server and select your connection. Session name can be any name.

Host is "morph-G.ist.unomaha.edu".



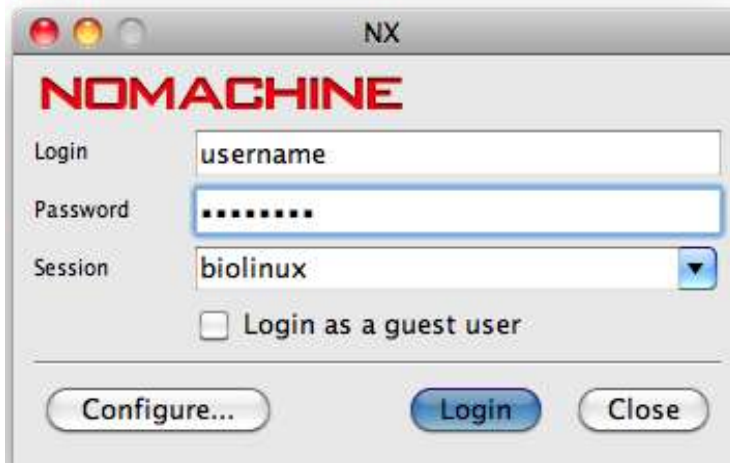
[D] Select Unix, GNOME, and screen resolution (1024x768).



[E] Click "Finish".



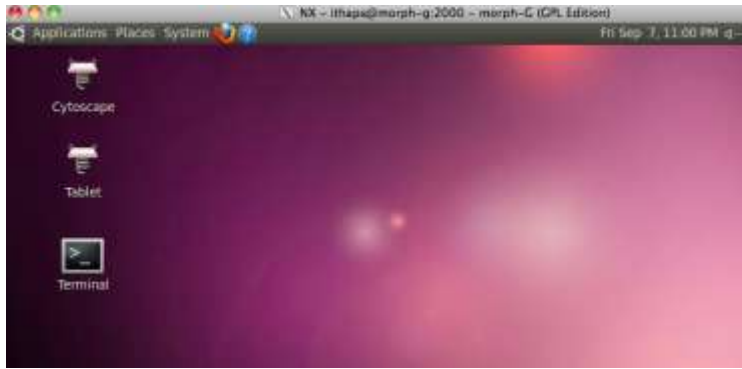
[F] Select the session “**biolinux**” and enter your username and password.



[G] Click “**Yes**”.
